SCHEDULING ORDER

The court grants Appellants' motion to expedite this appeal and notes all responses.

The court sets this case for oral argument at 1:30 p.m. on May 16, 2022. To accomplish this setting, the court expedites the briefing schedule as follows:

- Appellants must file a brief by no later than May 2, 2022;
- Appellees must file either a brief or a notice of intent not to file a brief by no later than May 9, 2022; and
- Appellants may file a reply brief by no later than May 12, 2022.

An amicus curiae must serve and file any application to file a brief of an amicus


curiae by no later than May 5, 2022.

- The applicant must attach the proposed amicus brief as an exhibit to the application.
- Any party's response to an application to file an amicus brief must be served and filed no later than two weekdays after the motion's file date or by 5 p.m. on May 9, 2022, whichever date is the latest.
- If the court grants a motion to file an amicus brief, a party may respond to the amicus brief by no later than May 12, 2022.

The court will not grant any extension of this briefing schedule.
